• What does this qualification cover?

This Framework qualification covers a very wide range of areas related to the skills and knowledge required to become competent within the pluming and domestic heating sector.

The following units are mandatory, the learner must then choose one of the optional pathways available. The mandatory units are:

- Understand and apply domestic cold water system installation, commissioning, service and maintenance techniques
