#### **OVERVIEW**

This is a Level 1 qualification that enables you to progress into further learning in the construction sector. You will learn practical skills that enable you to complete common tasks in carpentry, bricklaying, plastering, painting, tiling, plumbing and electrical trades. You will take this qualification if you wish to develop hand-skills to enable you to progress in to further learning in the construction industry.

## ABOUT THIS QUALIFICATION

This is a Framework qualification that enables you to develop hand-skills before progressing to further studies in construction. All of the units develop your practical skills and enable you to demonstrate your ability to complete common tasks within the construction industry.

You will learn common tasks in carpentry, bricklaying, plastering, painting, tiling, plumbing and electrical trades. The tasks are listed at the end of this document to help you make a choice of which trades you are interested in.

There are no entry requirements for this qualification – anyone over the age of 14 wishing to develop hand-skills in order to progress into further learning and training in construction can take this qualification.

# WHY TAKE THIS QUALIFICATION?

You will take this Level 1 Diploma if you have no previous experience in construction. You will be confident in your ability to undertake common tasks, and you will be confident that you want to progress on to further learning in construction trades.
