Qualification aim

These qualifications are to guide and assess development of knowledge, understanding and skills in leadership, management and/or advanced practice within health and social care and children and young people's services. These qualifications confirm competence in these areas. They can be used to meet qualification requirements for registration and regulation in some leadership and management

Qualification levels and definition

These are level 5 diplomas. City & Guilds does not set formal entry requirements for these qualifications, but they are suitable for people with experience in the broad care sector and wishing to progress in leadership and management roles.

Progression routes

There are a number of qualifications, such as the diplomas in health and social care, or the qualifications in learning disabilities, that allow progression into these leadership and management qualifications.

These qualifications are accepted as entry requirements to a number of HEI programmes. They can also provide continuing professional development (CPD).

Each qualification includes a set of

Structure

The qualification is assessed by portfolios of evidence and by assignment. All skills are assessed in the workplace via observation of performance. Knowledge can be assessed in or out of the workplace.
