Qualification aim

These qualifications support the development of learners' skills in research, critical thinking, reflection, problem solving, project management, extended writing and independent learning. These skills are important to learners' progress in other areas of their studies and help the transition to further study, higher education or employment. The Project qualifications are free-standing qualifications that can be taken as part of a wider programme of study.

Qualification levels and definition

The Higher Project allows learners to create an extended piece of work that can complement their Level 2 studies such as GCSEs, City & Guilds Technical Qualifications and Principal Learning or as part of a City & Guilds TechBac programme. The Extended Project can complement other Level 3 studies in City & Guilds Technical, A Levels, Principal Learning, NVQs and Apprenticeships, or can be taken as part of a City & Guilds TechBac programme. Alternatively the Extended Project qualification may explore an area of personal interest or activity outside the main programme of study.

Progression routes

After completing the Higher Project, learners may choose A Levels, City & Guilds Advanced Technical Qualifications, apprenticeships or seek employment. Completion of the Extended Project may allow learners to progress on to university or employment. Achievement of the Extended Project carries UCAS points as below. These can contribute towards a points offer from a university.
