Synoptic assignment material

Thank you to those tutors that provided feedback or questions during the synoptic assignment clarification window. The clarification window has closed, and we are reviewing any feedback.

Final synoptic assignments will be released to centres on **02 December 2024** and will be available to download from the relevant Qualifications pages of the City & Guilds website. Any changes or updates following centre feedback will be incorporated into final versions of the assignment and tutors must use the version published in December - you must not use previous versions.

The documents are password protected - the passwords can be found on the relevant qualification pages in Walled Garden.

Please be aware that for the 2025 synoptic assignments, new passwords will be added. Any previously used password will not open the synoptic assignment document.

Tutors must access the new password on the Walled Garden and are reminded of the importance of keeping all assessment passwords secure at all times.

Finally, please remember that students must not be provided with any synoptic material until after 06 January 2025.

8202 Plumbing synoptic assignment: update

As part of the synoptic assignment clarification window, we published the 2024/2025 synoptic assignment for **8202-026** Level 2 Plumbing to give centres an opportunity ahead of delivery to review and provide any feedback or queries.

We were made aware of some centre concerns regarding both the scenario and the resource materials needed within the synoptic. On reflection, we have decided to replace the synoptic with a new version for use - taking into account the concerns around the main focus of the original synoptic and the resources needed to delivery across centres.

A new Level 2 Plumbing - synoptic assignment (8202-026) has now been published to the documents on the 8202 qualification page.



As detailed above, this synoptic assignment can be accessed using a password available via the Walled Garden. (Please note the previous password has been changed, please use the new password).

We would like to thank those centres that raised queries or concerns regarding the original synoptic assignment.

External quality assurance activities

As part of the annual external quality assurance cycle for Technical Qualifications, centre activities have started to commence.

Moderators have begun to liaise with centres regarding advisory activities, standardisation activities and visits for centre-assessed components (planned visits and short-notice visits).

From January 2025, synoptic visits will commence. Please note that not all centres will receive a synoptic visit. However, if your centre has been selected for a synoptic visit, you will receive notification from City & Guilds by 30 November 2024.
