Qualification approval window for Technical Qualifications

Centres will not be able to register any students onto Technical Qualifications if you do not already have approval for the qualification.

Where you require approval to deliver a Technical Qualification, an application must be submitted via Walled Garden.

All qualification approval applications for delivery in 2024-2025 must be received prior to the qualification approval window closing on 04 October 2024.
