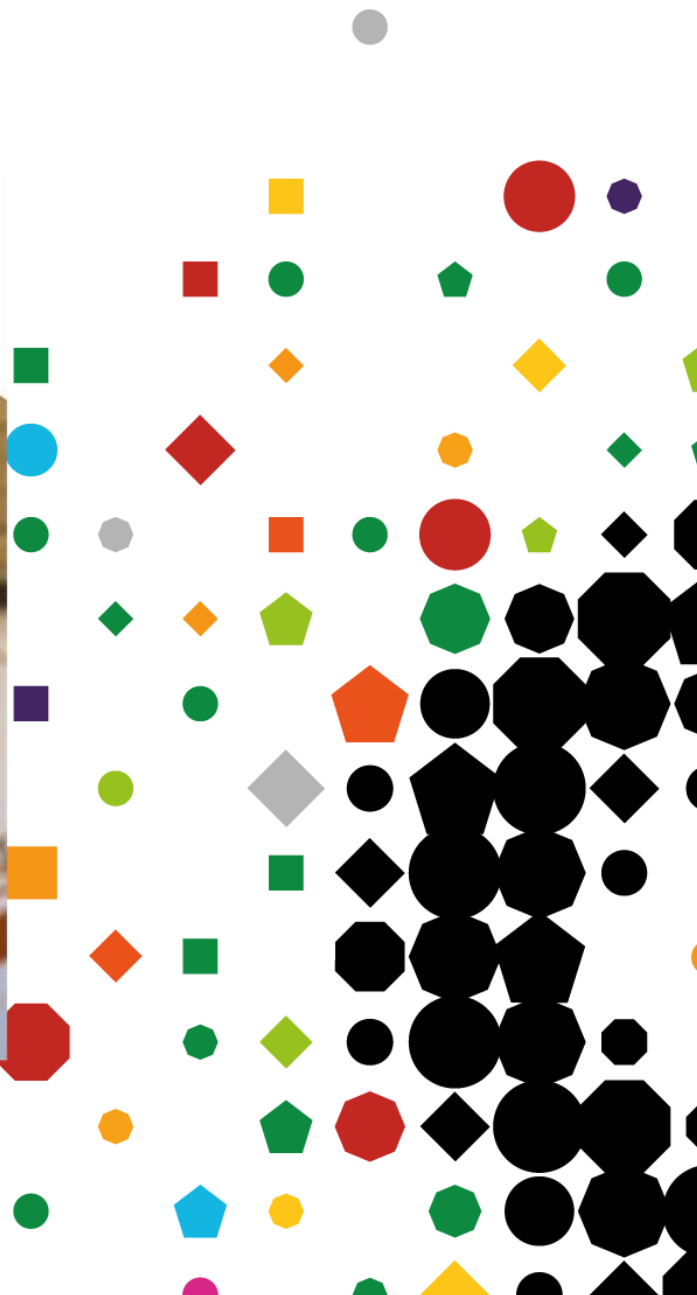

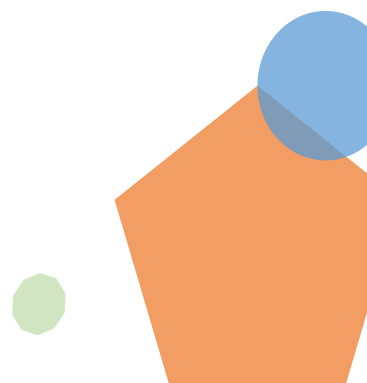

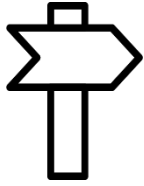

For candidates registered on 7120 qualifications for 2024/25, we can now confirm that they should be assessed on synoptic assessment C4.

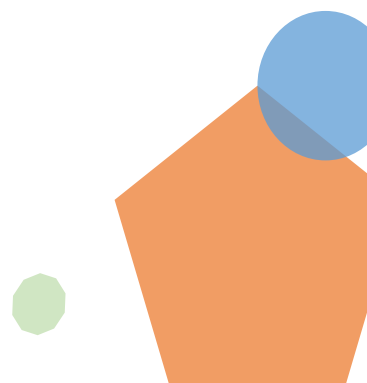

A few reminders from the Lead Independent End Point Assessors for customers using us for EPA for the Hospitality Team Member Standards.

The business project must not be completed until the proposal has been agreed at the initial meeting by the End Point Assessor.

The word count of 800-1200 words must not be exceeded for the business project

The business project needs to meet all of the listed criteria found in the EPA pack.

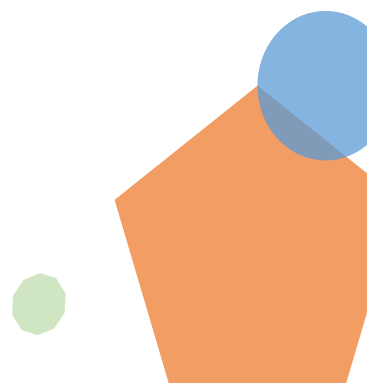
