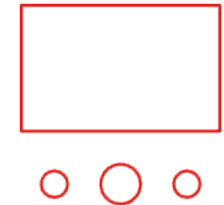

Assessor Comments

Assessor Comments

- **General – Naming Conventions** – Relevant naming conventions should be used in evidence uploads –clear differentiation between the Project Report and the Portfolio.
- **General – Uploads** – Uploads need to be timely. Assessment dates are planned in to ensure availability of the IEPA and also to comply with timescales set.
- **General – Evidence Matrix** – Within the Recording Forms on EPA Pro, there is an evidence Matrix to be used – ensure this is completed and uploaded.
- **General – Word Counts** – Where a word count is stated, ensure apprentices are within the tolerance of this.
- **General – Dates** – When booking assessment dates, ensure the apprentice has been given enough time to complete the project, giving 2 weeks between upload and assessment.
- **General – Portfolio Evidence** – Evidence compiled in the submitted portfolio should not be marked or assessed, if the evidence has been previously assessed, then this is not accepted. Evidence should be reviewed by the assigned IEPA only.
- **Digital Marketer – TC's & Min requirements** – Ensure all TC's are fully covered, making use of the minimum requirements.

Task 5: Maintaining network security

Introduction

As a Network Engineer, you will need to develop an understanding of the fundamental concepts of operating securely, ensuring the confidentiality of data and system integrity. The concepts explored as part of this task include:

- applying security measures such as assigning file-level permissions
- configuring security devices such as firewalls
- intrusion detection systems (IDS)
- intrusion prevention systems (IPS)
- sharing, file and folder permissions
- users and groups.

Key terms

Active Directory (AD) – a database and set of services that allow users to access network resources.

Attack vector – the path or means by which an attacker can gain access to a network or system in order to deliver a payload or carry out malicious activities.

Authentication – the process of determining whether someone is, in fact, who they say that they are.

Biometric authentication – compares data from a person's characteristics to that person's biometric 'template' to determine if they match. If these characteristics match the stored information, they are granted access to the system.

Countermeasure – the protection that mitigates against potential risks.

Encryption – the process of converting information or data into a code, to prevent unauthorised access.

File permissions – system settings that determine who can access specified files and what they can do with those files.

Firewall – a network security system that monitors and controls incoming and outgoing network traffic based on predetermined set of security rules.

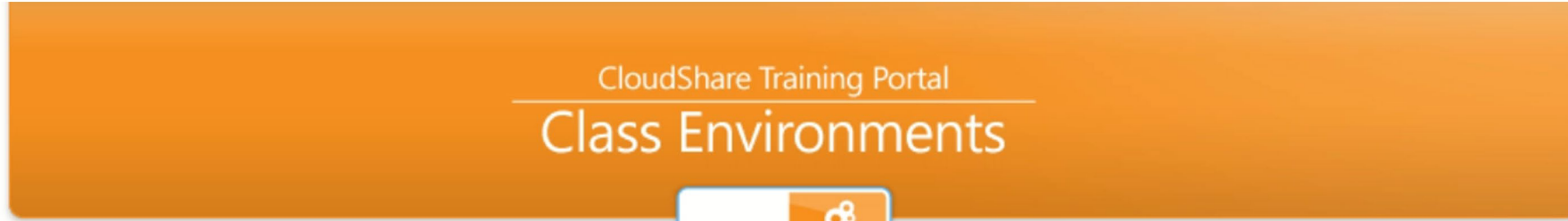

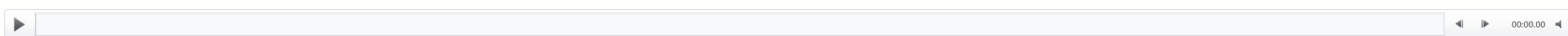
