Our focus on supporting the sector through times of change is unwavering, demonstrated by our continued investments

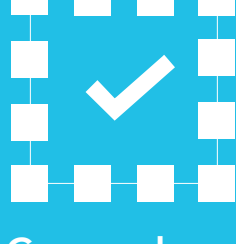
into land based services from NPTC to our bursary programmes.

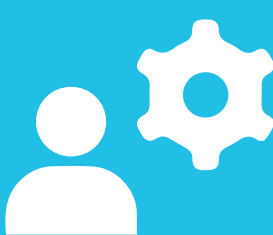
