What are digital credentials?

Digital credentials are easy-to-share and fully verifiable online badges that enable you to instantly showcase your skills with your professional networks and potential employers at the click of a button.

Issued to you on successful completion of your programme or qualification, each badge acts as a digital certificate. It safely stores all the information about the knowledge, skills and behaviours that you demonstrated throughout your learning journey. Unlike a paper certificate, your credential will never go missing.

Using our digital credentials platform, you can quickly share your badge via social media channels such as LinkedIn, Facebook and X, as well as adding them to emails or embedding them into your own website or blogs.

Find out how to access your digital credentials, so you can proudly display your achievements anytime, anywhere.



Set yourself up to receive digital credentials

In order to receive your digital credentials, you will need to provide your personal email address.

- If you do not have an email address then you will need to create a new account
- Register for an email account with Outlook, Yahoo, Gmail or any other recognised web-mail email services
- Please use your name when creating an account so you can use it when applying for jobs
- Using anything other than your name is not professional and will hinder your job applications

Additional guidance for prison leavers

- Contact your Employment and Resettlement Worker with your email address
- The Employment and Resettlement Worker will notify the Education Administration Team.

Access your digital credentials

Once you've successfully completed your qualification or programme, you will be notified by email that you've been awarded your digital credential.

Open the email and select 'View your achievement' to go to our digital credentials platform. From here you can easily view and share your digital credential(s). You can also see the data that sits behind your digital credential, including the details of your achievement, the skills and knowledge you demonstrated, the criteria and when it was issued.






Click on the button for the platform you want to share your digital credential, and follow the instructions.

If you have received more than one digital credential, you can view them all in your wallet by clicking 'View All Credentials'.


From here, you can click on the digital credential thumbnails to see the details of each digital credential, including the issuer, issue date and metadata as well as sharing options.
