




### From Flash to HTML

Functional Skills assessments have migrated from Flash to HTML.

We have updated the guidance document which is available from the 4748-qualification page which contains the answers to some frequently asked questions.

All live e-volve Reading, Writing and Mathematics exams at level 1 and level 2 are now in the new HTML format. Flash tests have been switched off. This means there is **no need** to use Surpass Viewer to take live tests.

## **Open Assess**


- Four HTML versions of samples are available for each subject and each level
- These can be sat and marked in an ordinary browser
- Score reports can be generated although Candidate Review (not currently available)
- Updated Open Assess guide is available on the Functional Skills qualification page.
- Flash samples can no longer booked for learners to take, but any exams already taken can be marked or reviewed.

## **HTML** calculator changes

### New calculator functionality

- A copy and paste function is now available
  - The keyboard shortcut for pasting content must be used - Ctrl & V, this is due to the Secure Client locking down the computer, so that the right click method on the mouse does not work.
- When inputting numbers into the calculator both the mouse and numeric keys on the keyboard can now be used.






## **Rules for Invigilation- Reminders**

- For Functional Skills Mathematics, candidates must be given both sections from the same version of the paper.
- Exam dates can be moved within the permitted window, but you must notify City & Guilds using the exam change notification form.

## **Access Arrangements**

#### Functional Skills English Reading

Reading within Functional Skills English qualifications is defined as the independent understanding of written language in specific contexts.

"Text" is defined as materials that include the use of words that are written, printed, onscreen or presented using Braille.


A computer reader may be used in the Reading component, providing it's the candidate's normal way of reading. A computer reader is an acceptable arrangement, since it still allows the candidate to independently meet the requirements of the reading standards.

A (human) reader cannot be used to demonstrate the requirements of the reading standards as this does not meet the requirement for independence. As a last resort, an exemption from the Reading component can be requested for a disabled candidate who cannot use assistive technology.

- Assessment Tracking document -we will be asking selected centres for the submission of specific assessments.


## Digital Functional Skills Qualifications




### **ESOL Skills for Life**

### Remote supervision of ESOL assessments

Following feedback from customers, we have decided to permit virtual supervision of ESOL SfL assessments. This includes Speaking/ Listening and Writing at all levels and Reading at Entry Levels. Reading at Level 1 And 2 must be invigilated, we do offer a Remote Invigilation service which can be used for these.

## **ESOL Skills for Life**

### Certification

- If learners are registered for the single mode awards (4692-01) then from now onwards, as well as claiming the unit they have completed, centres also need to claim a certification code in order to generate a certificate.
- These codes are in the 900 series (i.e. 4692-901)

### **Qualification end date extension**

 All ESOL qualifications end dates have been extended now.

## **Employability (5546)**

**Employability Skills** suite of qualifications contains a mixture of 'employability' and 'personal/social' skills units. All are assessed by portfolio.

## Maths and English: Bitesized qualifications

### Mathematics/English Skills (3847)

- Collection of small (10-20 hour) units, each of which focuses on a specific area of the adult numeracy and literacy national standards.
- 100 units in total (55 maths, 45 English), covering Entry 1 to Level 2
- Each unit is a qualification in its own right; can also be combined into larger 'themed' awards and certificates.
- Portfolio-assessed with no externally set assignments or exams.

### **Principles of Mathematics/English (3844)**

- Covers substantive parts of the adult numeracy and literacy standards, with a particular focus on receptive skills, knowledge and understanding.
- Assessment through a one-off on-screen test – available on-demand with instant results.
- Enables learners to demonstrate a solid grasp of the key principles of maths and English, as well as the resilience to operate effectively in a test environment.
- Available at Entry 3 to Level 2.

## **Personal Progress (3803)**

Personal Progress is a suite of qualifications at Entry Level 1

Designed to **support learners to become more independent** and develop skills in a range of areas including:

- Communication
- Reading and Writing
- Mathematics
- Independent live
- Workplace skills

Currently last **registration date** is showing as end of December 2023, we are intending to extend it.


