

These qualifications are available at various levels and are suitable for different learning environments, including colleges and apprenticeships. They focus on foundational skills and real-life applications to support employment and further studies.

Flexible assessment options include paper-based or online tests, available on-demand to fit learners' schedules.

Mathematics/English Skills (3847 – Bitesized)

•Collection of small (10-20 hour) units, each of which focuses on a **specific area** of the adult numeracy and literacy national standards.

•100 units in total (55 maths, 45 English), covering Entry 1 to Level 2

•Each unit is a qualification in its own right; can also be combined into larger 'themed' awards and certificates.

•Portfolio-assessed – with no externally set assignments or exams.

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Each unit can either be recognised as a qualification in its own right, or combined into larger qualifications

- Themed Awards
 - Mathematics **Number** (3-6 units)

- Certificates
 - Mathematics across the whole standard (10-12 units)

- Qualification handbook sets out rules of combination, and other administrative/delivery requirements.





Further documents

Logbook

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- Used to record, track and locate evidence.
- Each unit must be signedoff by candidate and assessor, once requirements have been met.
- Can be done electronically, using an e-portfolio system (eg Learning Assistant, or similar).

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
Unit pack

- Summarises content of each unit
 - useful when selecting units, as outcomes, criteria and guided learning hours can be seen at a glance

Core Curriculum

- Sets out teaching and learning expectations that underpin the adult numeracy/literacy national standards (on which these qualifications are based).
- Relevant Core Curriculum references are displayed within the Assessment Criteria for each unit, eg:





Principles of Mathematics/English (3844)

- Covers substantive parts of the adult numeracy and literacy standards, with a particular focus on receptive skills, knowledge and understanding.
- Assessment through a one-off on-screen test available on-demand with instant results.
- Enables learners to demonstrate a **solid grasp** of the key principles of maths and English, as well as the **resilience** to operate effectively in a test environment.
- Available at Entry 3 to Level 2.



Two tests for Mathematics



The Entry Level 1 Qualifications in Personal Progress help learners at Entry 1 or below develop essential skills for active community participation and personal growth through flexible unit packages. <section-header>

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Digital Functional Skills

The Augmentative and Alternative Communication qualifications at Entry Levels 2, 3, and Level 1 help learners who have no natural speech develop effective nonverbal communication skills. Digital Functional Skills Qualifications help learners at Entry Level 3 and Level 1 build confidence and fluency in digital skills for safe engagement in various contexts, preparing them for work, life, and further study.

Further additional learner opportunities



ESOL Skills for Life qualifications, available at Entry 1, 2 & 3 and Levels 1 & 2, help UK-based individuals improve their English for work, study, accessing public services, and functioning effectively in an English-speaking environment.



Employability Skills qualifications at Entry 2, Entry 3, Level 1 and Level 2 help individuals gain jobs, progress in their fields, prepare for further study, and develop techniques for independent living.

The Extended Project is a freestanding Level 3 qualification that offers learners a chance to demonstrate self-direction, complementing other studies or personal interests, carrying up to 28 UCAS points for university applications.


