



Current versions will be removed, and learners must not sit these on or after 2nd September 2024.


Centres must destroy any digital or paper copies of the current assessments.

Functional Skills for apprentices

The Department of Education has published the Apprenticeship funding rules for (August 2024 to July 2025), a copy is available on this link: <u>Apprenticeship funding rules 2024 to 2025</u> (<u>publishing.service.gov.uk</u>)

Where an apprentice who has a learning difficulty or disability which is a barrier to them being able to achieve the maths and English requirements, providers should consider whether they should be offered the flexibility to achieve Entry 3 Functional Skills in the relevant subject(s).

We are currently developing some additional guidance to support providers, which will be available from the <u>Apprenticeship Support Hub</u> shortly.

If you are currently delivering Level 1 and Level 2 Functional Skills qualifications to apprentices but now need to consider delivering the Entry 3 qualifications, which have a different style of assessment, please get in touch with us so that we can support you with this process.



More than a line on a CV, digital credentials provide verifiable proof of an achievement.


All the information is packed into an image file that can be displayed via online CVs and social networking sites such as LinkedIn, Facebook or Twitter.

Free and easy to set up- just add learners' personal email address during the registration on Walled Garden.




