OVERVIEW

- What does this qualification cover?

This qualification covers a very wide range of areas related to the skills and knowledge required for preparing to work in the Hair and Media Make up Industry.

The following units can be covered within this qualification:

- Working with colleagues within the beauty related industries
- Monitor and maintain health and safety practice in the salon
- Creative hairdressing design skills
- Design and apply face and body art
- Fashion and photographic make-up
- Apply airbrush make-up to the face
- Camouflage make-up
- Apply make-up
- Provide eyelash and brow treatments
- The art of colouring hair
- Provide self tanning
- Apply Individual permanent lashes
- Media make-up
- Style and fit pastiche
- Provide hair extension services
- Style and dress hair using a variety of techniques
- Studio photography
- Principles of studio photography

All learners will complete a number of mandatory units and optional units which will allow the learner to gain the knowledge and experience that is required to work as a Hair and Media Make up Artist within the Hair and Media Make up Industry.

To be a professional Hair and Media Make up Artist, a learner must have accomplished both aspects of hairdressing and media make up.



This is a Framework qualification.

Who could take this qualification?

For learners who are interested in a career in the Hair and Media Make up. This qualification is extremely popular as it covers both aspects of hairdressing and media make up. This qualification would allow a learner to work as a freelance operator or work for a fashion and media make up company, working on hair and media make up photographic shoots, for magazines, media, television or film work and special occasion events such as weddings.

This qualification is suitable for anyone from 16 years old or over to take this qualification.

WHAT COULD THIS QUALIFICATION LEAD TO?

This qualification could lead to jobs such as:

- Hair and Media Make up Artist

The learner could progress onto an apprenticeship at Level 3 in Beauty Therapy- Make up, or other qualifications such as:

- Level 3 Diploma in Theatrical, special effects, hair and media make up
- Level 3 Diploma in Hairdressing
- Level 4 Diploma in Management Practice and Advanced Techniques in the Hair and Beauty Sector – Theatrical and Media Make-Up
- Level 4 Certificate in Advanced Theatrical and Media Make up

This qualification also allows learners to progress into employment as a professional hair and Media make up artist

WHO SUPPORTS THIS QUALIFICATION?

This qualification is supported by the FHT and NHF who are Professional Associations for the Hair and Make up industries. As most Hair and Media Make up artists work as freelance operators the professional associations for both hairdressing and beauty (which includes media make up) recognise and support this qualification and would accept membership to both their organisations. When developing the qualification with employers and professional associations it was clear to gain employment within this industry a learner needed to study both hairdressing and media make up. As many fashion and photographic shoots require someone to be able to carry out a range of skills.
