OVERVIEW

- What does this qualification cover?

This qualification covers a very wide range of areas related to the skills and knowledge required for working in the Agricultural industry, or progressing to further learning and training.

All learners must take the mandatory units:

Undertake Work-related experience in the Land-based Industries
Environmental and Land-based business
Introduction to Crop Establishment
Introduction to Farm Animal Production

You can then take optional units that are relevant to the chosen area of interest such as:

Introduction to Crop Establishment
Introduction to Land-based Machinery Operations
Introduction to Animal and Plant Husbandry

This is a Framework qualification.

It reflects the skills and knowledge needed to progress onto a Level 3 qualification, or into employment.
