OVERVIEW

- What does this qualification cover?

This qualification covers a very wide range of areas related to the skills and knowledge required for working in the equine industry, or progressing to further learning and training.

All learners must take the mandatory units:

Undertake Work Related Experience in the Land-based Industries
Carry Out and Understand the Principles of Feeding and Watering Horses
Undertake Routine Stable Duties
Undertake Horse Handling

You can then take optional units such as the following:

Undertake Horse Grooming, Trimming and Plaiting
Introduction to Caring for Competition Horses
Introduction to the Principles of Horse Behaviour
Introduction to Equine Stud Practice
Introduction to Riding Horses over Fences

This is a Framework qualification.

- Who could take this qualification? OR who is this qualification designed for?

This qualification is a centre-based qualification designed to be taken in a College environment.

It reflects the skills and knowledge needed to progress into employment or onto a Level 3 qualification.

There are no specific prior achievements required to take this qualification, but a Level 1 or another Level 2 qualification in other Land-based related subjects could be an advantage.

You need to be 16 years old or over to take this qualification.

WHAT COULD THIS QUALIFICATION LEAD TO?

This qualification could lead to jobs such as:

- Assistant Groom
- Stud Assistant/Hand
- Trek Assistant
