- What does this qualification cover?

This qualification covers a very wide range of areas related to the skills and knowledge required for working in the Horticultural industry, or progressing to further learning and training.

All learners must take 2 of the following mandatory units:

or

Understand the Basic Principles of Soil Science

or

Setting out From a Plan

You then need to take units from the range of options that could include:

Construct Alpine and Water Features

Construct Landscape Foundations and Surfaces

Contribute to Establishing and Maintaining Amenity Turf

Contribute to Fruit and Vegetable Cultivation

Maintain Sports Turf Surfaces - Association Football

This is a Framework qualification.

- Who could take this qualification? OR who is this qualification designed for?

This qualification is a centre-based qualification designed to be taken in a College environment.

It reflects the skills and knowledge needed to progress onto a Level 3 qualification, or into employment.

There are no specific prior achievements required to take this qualification, but a Level 1 or another Level 2 qualification in Horticulture or other Land-based related subjects could be an advantage.

This qualification is suitable for any age group.
