What does this qualification cover?

This qualification covers the advanced practical skills and knowledge required to work in wood machining roles within the furniture industry.

You will take the following mandatory units

- Health and safety within furniture and furnishing making environments
- Manufacturing wood-based components using powered tools
- Manufacturing wood-based components using sanding machines
- Sustainability in the timber trade
- Environmental management and waste management in woodmachining
- Manage the production of wood-based components using machines
- Manufacturing wood-based components using profiling machines
- Workflow management in wood machining

This is a Framework qualification.

Who could take this qualification?

This qualification is suitable if you wish to pursue a career in wood machining roles within the furniture industry. Ideally you should already have completed the Level 2 Diploma in Wood Machining (600/1976/1) or have an understanding of basic wood machining skills.

This qualification is suitable if you are aged 14 years old or over.
